Dress for Success

Cedar Ridge PDS Elementary has a mode of dress that provides students with several choices, yet ensures that all our children are "dressed for success." In addition to the district's dress code found in the student handbook, our mode of dress for the school year is outline below. There have been some changes for the 2014 - 2015 school year.

Slacks, skirts, capris, jumpers, or knee-length shorts:

- Slacks, skirts, capris, jumpers, and/or shorts must be made of a twill material.
- Appropriate colors include black, navy or khaki.
- Students may <u>NOT</u> WEAR zippered legged or decorated pants of any type, blue jeans, denim, or cargo pants (extra pockets on side of pant legs).
- Slacks, shorts, capris, and skirts must be worn at the waist at all times. **NO SAGGING.**
- Skirts and shorts must be fingertip length when standing.

Shirts or blouses:

- Polo style, collared shirts **must be solid**. Decals should be no bigger than a quarter.
- Solid blouses or dress shirts are permitted.
- T-shirts are **NOT** permitted unless they are a current Cedar Ridge school t-shirt.
- All shirts must be tucked in.
- Students wearing sweatshirts **cannot** put the hood over their heads.

Belts:

• Belts must be worn with ALL looped pants.

Shoes:

- All shoes must have a back.
- No roller shoes are permitted
- No flip-flops or open-toed shoes

Hair:

• Hair must NOT be dyed to extremes, and haircuts which are unusual or bizarre such as mohawks, lines, words, numbers, and design shapes <u>WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.</u>

If you have any questions about whether an article of clothing is allowable, please call us **before** you send the child to school. Also, please make sure you have dress code clothing clean and ready for your child each school day. No clean clothing is not an acceptable excuse for being out of dress code.
