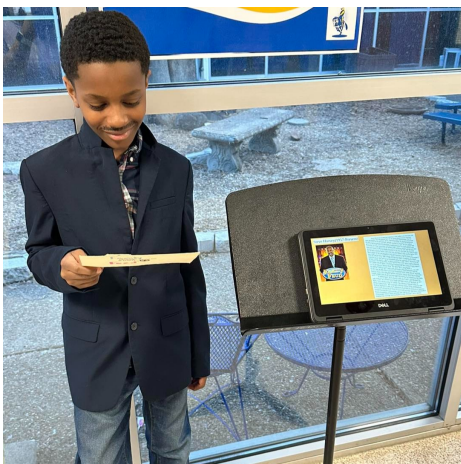


H-E-B Celebrity Cookoff
