Turn in Directions

The following directions should be followed prior to the first day of school to minimize instructional time lost in class. Any excess supplies are to be kept to replenish the student's binder as needed.

Be sure to clip the dividers into your binder or Trapper Keeper along with 1 package of notebook paper. Clip the pencil pouch in with the following supplies inside:
