Middle School and High School Dress Code

Students must be in dress code the first day of orientation and every day there after:

High school students

Navy colored pullover shirt (tee or collared), sweat shirt, khaki pants, belt (black, brown, or khaki), and athletic shoes: navy, white, black or gray. A sweatshirt can be worn as an outer garment for warmth or students may wear a long sleeve navy or white shirt underneath a required short sleeve shirt. A maximum of two shirts may be worn and ALL must be free of designs or logos and cannot be worn inside out. Although both shirts must be tucked in at all times, sweat shirts may be worn outside the pants. Shorts, skinny leg pants, and capris are not allowed. Students are expected to wear clothing appropriately.

Middle school students

Light gray colored pull over shirt (tee or collared), sweat shirt, khaki pants, belt (black, brown, or khaki), and athletic shoes navy, white, black or gray. A sweatshirt can be worn as an outer garment for warmth or students may wear a long sleeve gray or white shirt underneath a required short sleeve shirt. A maximum of two shirts may be worn and ALL must be free of designs or logos and cannot be worn inside out. Although both shirts must be tucked in at all times, sweat shirts may be worn outside the pants. Shorts, skinny leg pants, and capris are not allowed. Students are expected to wear clothing appropriately. Shorts, skinny leg pants, and capris are not allowed. Students are expected to wear clothes appropriately.

Note: No cellphones are allowed – A fee of \$15.00 will be charged to any student in violation of this policy, with parent pickup only.

No jewelry or headbands of any kind are allowed, wrist bands, rings, no piercing of any kind, earring, and watches necklaces.
