IDs: ID should be visible at all times

Masks: covering the mouth and nose

Shirts: must have sleeves; hem must go beyond the waist of pants, and no lewd pictures/advertisements/language.

Pants: no sagging; no holes/rips/tears above the knees, and no pajamas.
