AVID offers activities and WICOR strategies to improve academics for all core areas. AVID students must take higher level classes to apply AVID strategies. Students are to maintain an "85" or above in all classes and get 10 hours of community service. They are required to apply to at least three universities and scholarships. Coach Torres and Ashley Bridgewater are the two AVID elective teachers/coaches.
- V. CIP Campus Improvement Plan: Athena Nuness

The Campus Improvement Plan was approved at last board meeting.
